Logging-in to the Saudi Digital Library:

- From the home page of the college website – Faculty Member & Employee/ Students.
- Choose Blackboard System Service, a Saudi Digital Library or an Electronic Library System service.
- Sign in with your username and password on the Blackboard system.
- You will be redirected to the Saudi Digital Library website by clicking on the Saudi Digital Library link.

Research methods in the Saudi Digital Library

The search process in the Saudi Digital Library is based on the possibility of searching in several ways in order to facilitate access to the sources of information shared by the library.

Unified Search:

- When you search, for example, (respiratory system anatomy), results will appear from all sources shared by the Saudi Digital Library. Note that filters and selectors can be used to narrow the search process

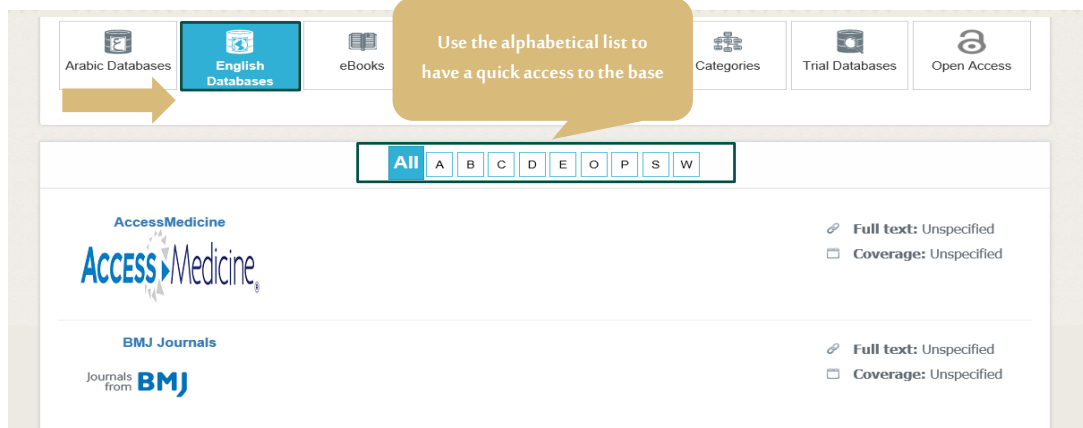

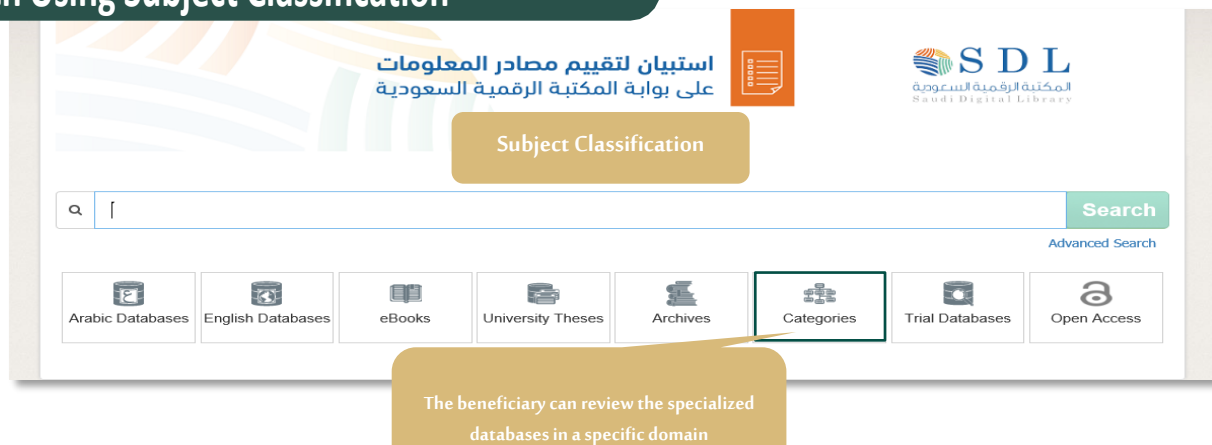

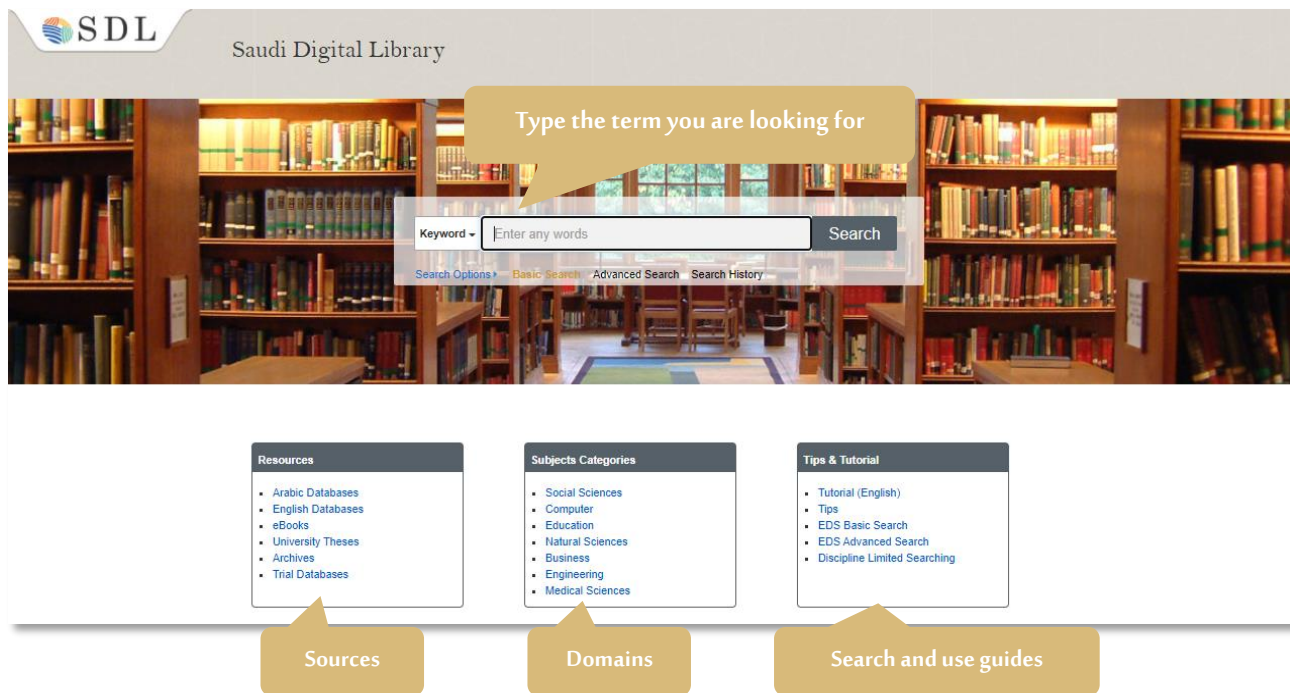

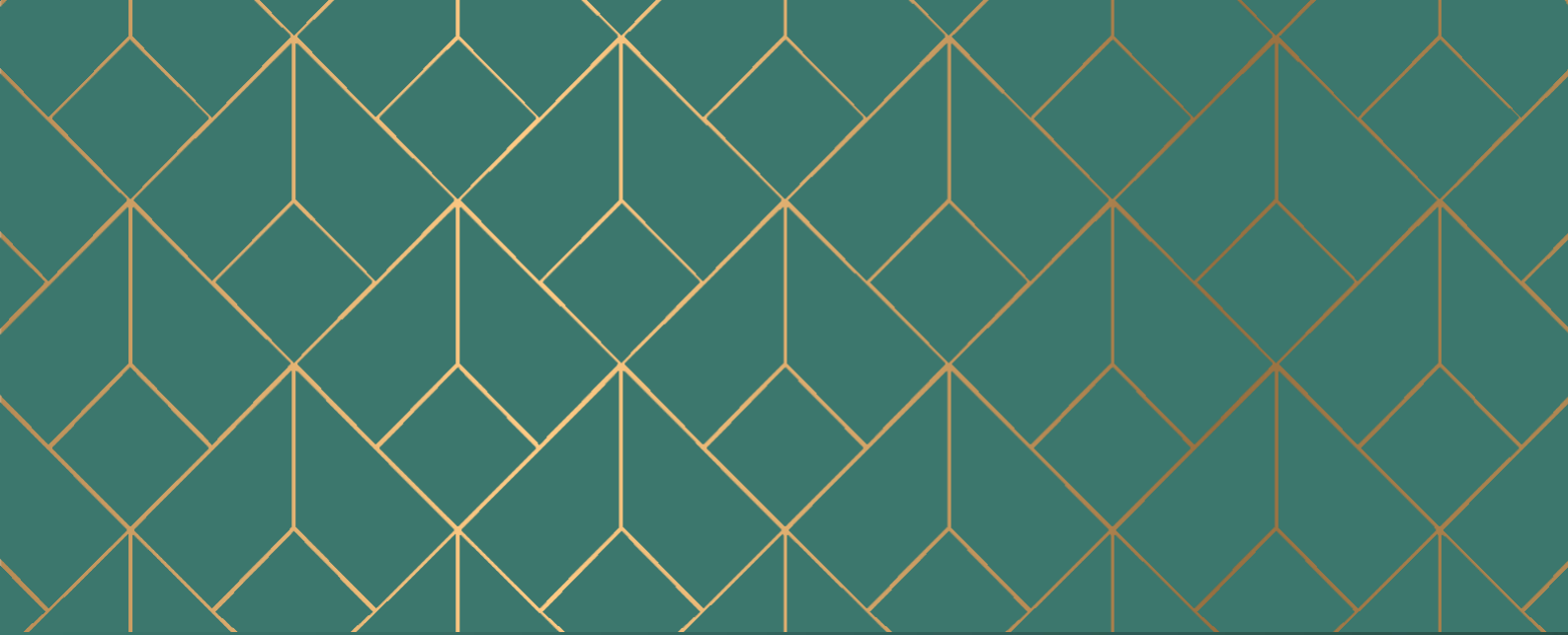
